Unexpected does not have to mean unprepared. It is only a Crisis if you are not Prepared! Remain Calm and Be Prepared!!! An Emergency is The Absence of Choice....

Are you hiding your head in the sand putting emergency disasters out of your mind? Are you expecting others to provide you with emergency supplies during an emergency? Well, that's interesting! Please know your neighbors may not have enough emergency supplies for you. The BCC cache is actually NOT going to have supplies for you. It contains, stretchers, bandages, search and rescue backpacks, hard hats and the like. The CERT trained members of the community will first secure their own families and

situation and then will head out to check on people in the community to see if they are trapped and/or need medical help (wounds, broken bones, etc.). It really is important to have your own stash of supplies.

Random Notes:

Reminder: It is the beginning of wildfire season.....

A good rule of thumb is to ALWAYS fill your vehicle gas tank when it reaches half full. This way you will always have some fuel. If a disaster occurs, even if the power is still on to pump gas, you will not be able to get fuel because police, fire, other first responders all will have priority over you to get gas.

Just a note of information: The Certification of all of our CERT trained community members has expired. We all took the training before 2020 and our certifications expired during the pandemic. We are now working to take some refresher course work in order to get recertified. So far one person has completed the simplified recertification criteria.

!! Items of the Month !! Road Trip Preparation! It's the time of year when road trips become a way to "vacation" during the milder weather. It's important to have emergency supplies in the vehicle for "just in case." Some of these items are logical others maybe not so much:

- First Aid Kit
- Road Flares
- Flashlight
- Knife
- Jug of Water (for overheated radiator)
- Properly Inflated Spare Tire
- Extra Drinking Water
- Snacks
- JumpStart Tool (charged) or Jumper Cables
- Tire Inflator (charged)

- Shrill Whistle
- Solar Phone Charger
- Duct Tape
- Tool Kit
- Gloves
- Paper Towels or Absorbent Cloth
- Poncho
- Tow Rope 🗍

Recipe Corner!

Crustless Rhubarb Custard Pie Easy Recipe

Ingredients

- 3 cups rhubarb diced
- 1/3 cup flour
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar
- 1/2 tsp. baking powder
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 4 large eggs
- 1 Tbl. vanilla extract
- 1 cup milk

• 1 tsp. butter softened, used to grease the pie plate

Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees Fahrenheit. Clean & dice rhubarb.

 Very generously spread softened butter on the bottom & sides of pie plate. Add diced rhubarb.
Mix remaining ingredients in blender until well

blended, 1 or 2 minutes. Pour over rhubarb.


4. Bake 40 minutes at 375 degrees. When done, center will be ever so slightly jiggly. That will firm up once removed from the oven & let sit for 10-15 minutes.
